

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Camping Atlantide and Amusement Park

Campground rules

-The following rules are being enforced so that our clientele may have an enjoyable stay at **Atlantide Campgrounds**; however, if these rules are not followed the management reserves the right to evict, without reimbursement.

Environment

- It is strictly forbidden to destroy or damage all that is natural fauna or flora or to cut, remove bark or branches from our trees on or around the camp site under a strict fine of **200\$**, plus eviction from the site, without reimbursement.

- It is equally forbidden to hang clotheslines, hammocks, swings etc because anything that is nailed to a tree will harm it.

- All vacationers must keep their lot clean and free of all debris, paper, bottles etc.

- Avoid leaving your firewood scattered and having too much clutter under your camper and this at all times. The renter must take care of his (her) site at all times.

- All rental lots must be finished in grass and kept in shape. Grass must be cut at least once every 10 days, if this is not done the management will take it upon themselves to do it at a cost of **20\$**. Hours for cutting your grass are: **Monday to Friday 1000H to 1700H, Saturday 1000H to 1400H. NO GRASS CUTTING ON SUNDAY.** Watering the grass is on Wednesday between 2100H and 2200H for 20 minutes only.

- All garbage must be placed in the proper recipients as it will not be picked up in front of your RV/trailer. The recipients around park and pool area's are strictly for these area's only, all personal garbage must be picked up everywhere even in the forest and deposited in the proper recipients.

- Dogs must always be on a leash or tied up outside your camper. Dog's should always be walked by an adult only. If your dog's barking disturbs the neighbor's you will be invited to remove your dog from the campgrounds.

- Dog droppings must always be picked up no matter where.

- Dogs are forbidden in all public areas, example: Amusement park, public toilet, re restaurant, pool area etc. **It is forbidden to have a cat, only dogs are permitted.**

STRICTLY FORBIDDEN

- Clothes line
- Sling shot, air gun or any such weapon
- Fireworks
- Washing clothes or dishes in public sinks
- No commercial activities are allowed. Permission (with a fee) must be obtained to sell your recreational vehicle on our premises.
- No vehicles are allowed to park in the street, they must be on your property. Visitor's included.
- Avoid disturbing loud noises TV, radio, etc.
- All noise must stop at 2300H **without exception**. Before 2300H moderate noise is tolerated.
- All campers and or visitors must respect the camp limits. Where marked **PRIVATE PROPERTY** or **DO NOT PASS** these zones are **no tolerance zones**.
- All TV satellites must be mounted on camper or RV and not on a post or tree.
- For decorative lighting, please use solar lights.

BEING IN POSSESSION OF, CONSUMPTION OF, GIVING OF OR SELLING OF DRUGS OF WATEVER NATURE AND FOR WHATEVER REASON IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AT PARK ATLANTIDE, THESE ACTIONS WILL BRING IMMEDIATE EVICTION (PERMANENTLY) AND NO REFUND.

SECURITY

- Road signs must be strictly respected on site.
- It is forbidden to drive a VTT, motor-cross, mini-bike or any such vehicle on site.
- All fires must be extinguished by 2400H without exception. Fires are only allowed on a designated spot and when fire warning allows. **FIRES ARE NOT FOR BURNING DEBRIS**. All onsite fire places must be approved by management.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult in the park and pool areas. **Our personnel are not BABAYSITTERS**.
- Golf carts are allowed and must be registered (with a small registration fee) with the management. Children under 16 driving a cart must be accompanied by an adult.
- No outside companies are allowed on the site unless authorized by management.

- The entrance to the park is open from 800H to 2300H. All residents must have a special key to enter and exit before or after these hours.

VISITORS

- **Everyone** on site must be registered. Visitors must leave their registration card in their car in clear view and upon departure registration card must be returned to reception.
- Visitors to onsite campers must also be registered and follow above mentioned rules and the residents are responsible for said visitor(s). Visitors must leave campgrounds at 2200H or must pay **6\$** per person per adult/extra night. Children under 3 stay free (with proof of age).
- No additional tents are authorized to be erected on lots to lodge visitors.
- It is the responsibility of the resident camper to advise his visitors of his (her) lot number and the whereabouts of such lot before arriving. At no time are our personnel authorized to divulge any information concerning our clientele, their site number or any other information.

SERVICES

- It is forbidden to hook up to or use another lot without permission.
- It is **strictly forbidden** to overcharge your electrical unit or to waste water. Every lot has 1 electrical outlet and 1 water faucet. If your requirements are above normal, please advise management and we will try to remedy the situation to the best of our ability. Cars are not permitted to be washed on site and RV's can be washed once a year either before the 21st of June (not during long weekend of May) and after Labor Day weekend in September.
- Any additional refrigerator must be locked and stored in a secure shed for your security and that of the children.
- Picnic tables are not supplied with your lot rental; however, we do rent them out for the season.

CONSTRUCTION

- If any construction work is required on your site please advise the management of these changes. All work must be executed between opening of the park in May and June 15th or after the 1st of September and park closing. It is strictly forbidden to use a chain saw or an electric saw or any tools that are noisy during these two periods.
- When purchasing or constructing a storage shelter or a shed you are not to exceed 8x10 in dimension but can be made of any material you choose as long as it is clean and in good taste. The owner of the site reserves the right to inspect such construction to make sure it is in good taste. If in doubt as the management.

WINTERIZATION AND OR STORAGE

- Snow removal on or around camper/RV must be done by the renter or the site owner. No commercial company will be allowed on the premises.

DEPARTURE OR SALE

- If you sell or remove your Camper/RV from our site, amount paid is not reimbursable. Please advise management of sale of your camper/RV as we reserve the right to accept or refuse the new owner on our site.

All rules and regulations enumerated above are subject to modification, change and/or adjustment at anytime by the owners of ATLANTIDE FAMILY CAMPING.

I declare having read all the rules and regulations established by **ATLANTIDE CAMPING** and accept them as is, I also realize that the owner may evict, without reimbursement, whomever breaks these conditions.
